

LiveCycle ES2: Introduction to Rights Management

Course length: 1 day

Course Description

This workshop is designed as an introduction to LiveCycle Rights management ES2. In addition to providing you with theory about Rights Management features, a large segment of the training is devoted to hands-on exercises as well as demonstrations.

For each lesson, we will start with an activity to introduce you to some of the concepts that will be covered in the lesson. We will then cover the content of the lessons using a combination of lectures and demonstrations. We will finish off each lesson with an exercise where you can put into practice the functionality covered in the lesson. The exercises are divided into tasks and build upon each other.

To complete this workshop, there is a self-paced and self-assessed lab. The lab consists of a set of requirements from which you must create your own end-to-end solution that implements the functionality covered during this workshop. Most of the workshop is spent in the LiveCycle Administrative User Interface and Adobe Acrobat. You will also touch on the integrated development environment (IDE) of LiveCycle, Adobe® LiveCycle Workbench ES2. In this IDE you will design processes with the Rights Management ES2 module as we complete an application used to apply a policy to a document.

Performance-Based Objectives

The main objective of the workshop is to ensure that you can utilize an Adobe® LiveCycle Rights Management ES2 to protect documents. You will be able to create policy sets and policies and then apply them to documents using various methods.
