

# LiveCycle ES2.5: Introduction to Rights Management

## Course Description

This workshop is designed as an introduction to LiveCycle Rights management ES2. In addition to providing you with theory about Rights Management features, a large segment of the training is devoted to hands-on exercises as well as demonstrations.

Most of the workshop is spent in the LiveCycle Administrative User Interface and Adobe Acrobat. You will also touch on the integrated development environment (IDE) of LiveCycle, Adobe® LiveCycle Workbench ES2. In this IDE, you will design processes with the Rights Management ES2 module as we complete an application used to apply a policy to a document.

## Performance-Based Objectives

- Explore the benefits of using Rights Management to protect documents and discuss some real life use cases where Rights Management can be used
- Examine the various configurations that are required for the Rights Management server, and properly configure the server
- Discuss the purpose of policy sets and how they work; create and configure a new policy set
- Explore the encryption methods used by LiveCycle Rights Management ES2, along with the encryption options that are available as part of a policy definition; use the Rights Management user interface to create a policy
- Use Acrobat to apply policies to PDF documents; investigate the Acrobat interface features that are related to Rights Management
- Investigate how Rights Management ES2 can be configured to handle the addition of “external” users to the system
- Apply policies to a document on the server; explore the functionality of the Launchpad application; build a LiveCycle process that will apply a policy to a document; review the available Rights Management operations
